  You like reading **whenever** you have spare time.
- 2. He is shorter than his brother. (*though*)

  He is shorter than his brother **though** he is older by two years.
- 3. This game is over. (*unless*)

  This game is over **unless** we score one more goal.
- 4. The movie will not start. (*until*)

  The movie will not start **until** they close the entrance door.
- She plays basketball. (whenever)
   She plays basketball whenever she has the chance.
- 6. They ask for hamburgers. (*wherever*)

  They ask for hamburgers **wherever** they go for dinner.
