Conjunctions link two words, phrases or clauses.

*Linda likes to color. She likes to paint. (and)*

*Linda likes to color and paint.*



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### Answers

1. The painters finished the living room. They finished the kitchen. (*and*)  
The painters finished the living room **and** the kitchen.
2. Leila plays with dolls. Leila plays with toy cars. (*and*)  
Leila plays with dolls **and** toy cars.
3. You could finish your work. You could play outside. (*or*)  
You could finish your work **or** play outside.
4. Jenna likes hot chocolate. She does not like coffee. (*but*)  
Jenna likes hot chocolate **but** not coffee.
5. The twins visited their grandparents. They went to a restaurant. (*and*)  
The twins visited their grandparents **and** went to a restaurant.
6. You can have the blue marker. You can have the red marker. (*or*)  
You can have the blue marker **or** the red marker.
