3. The girls are playing their new video game. They bought it **themselves**.
4. Look at those apples in the orchard. Let's go pick **them**.
5. Jenna has roses in her garden. **Those** are beautiful flowers.
6. Get a new pencil. **Yours** is dull.
7. The dog is chasing its tail. It is making **itself** dizzy.
8. Can you lend Maya your ruler? **Hers** is broken.
9. Mark has a new bicycle. **His** got stolen.
10. Frank planted green beans. **These** grow early in the season.

A pronoun can refer to a noun or another pronoun.

*Ian built a city with his blocks. He made it all by **himself**.*

"Himself" refers to the pronoun "He" and the noun "Ian".
