She was singing a song **as** she was skipping to the park.
5. They will buy a new house. They win the big prize.
They will buy a new house **if** they win the big prize.
6. She drove the car. Mom was away.
Whenever mom was away, she drove the car.
7. Jill came tumbling. Jack had fallen.
After Jack had fallen, Jill came tumbling.
8. My mom was watching her favorite show. She was cooking dinner.
While she was cooking dinner, my mom was watching her favorite show.
