- 4. A sentence describing an action that will have happened in the future. <u>Hopefully, by year end she will have earned an A for her grade.</u>
- A sentence showing something that ended before another event happened.
 <u>Her friends arrived early to the library, and then everyone began</u> <u>studying.</u>
- 6. A sentence showing something happening in the future. <u>They will all go get some ice cream tonight.</u>
- A sentence showing an action being continuous over time. Sally and her friends have always eaten ice cream at the same restaurant since they were little.
- A sentence showing a recent action.
 <u>Her friend, Lily, just saw their teacher enter the library.</u>
