- Would you like to study with me? (no)
 No, I would not like to study with you.
- 2. Will you go to the park on Saturday? (yes) Yes, I will go to the park on Saturday.
- Can you answer the question? (no)
 <u>No, I cannot answer the question.</u>
- Have you seen this show before? (yes)
 Yes, I have seen this show before.
- 5. Did you want to order a pizza for dinner? *(no)* No, I didn't want to order a pizza for dinner.
- 6. Do you have his phone number? *(no)* <u>No, I do not have his number.</u>
- Could you help me with my homework please? (yes)
 Yes, I can help you with your homework.
- Is this his birthday? (yes)
 Yes, this is his birthday.
