

4. Mrs. Hilt saw 33 butterflies and 16 bees. Some of the butterflies were red and others were orange. If 20 of the butterflies were orange, how many of them were red?
5. Mrs. Hilt bought a pencil for 17 cents. After the purchase, she had 62 cents left. How much money did she have before she bought the pencil?

Answers

- $6 \times 50 = 300$ cents = \$3.00
She paid \$3.00 for all of the hot dogs.
- She read on 4 days (Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday, Sunday).
 $13 \times 4 = 52$
She read 52 books in one week.
- $50 - 5 - 25 = 20$
She will have 20 cents left.
- $33 - 20 = 13$
13 of the butterflies were red.
- $62 + 17 = 79$
She had 79 cents to start.
