Grade 2 Word Problems Worksheet

A plane is boarding and getting ready to take off.

1. There are 6 passengers in first class, 11 passengers in the business class and 80 passengers in the economy class. How many passengers are on the plane?
2. There are 4 rows of seats in each of first class and business class and there are 32 rows of seats in economy class. How many rows of seats are there on the plane?
3. There are three compartments for luggage and each compartment has a capacity of 25 pieces of luggage. The first two compartments are full up and the last one contains 8 pieces of luggage. How many pieces of luggage are there?



4. The catering staff prepared 50 trays of standard meals, 14 trays of vegetarian meals and 7 trays of kids' meals. How many trays of meals were prepared?

5. The flight attendant fills the catering cart with 67 cans of soda, 25 cans of juice and 15 boxes of cookies. How many cans of drinks are there?

6. Write the addition sentence that fits this: "There are 3 flight attendants serving the first class and business class and 6 flight attendants serving the economy class. There are 9 flight attendants working on the flight."

Answers

- $6 + 11 + 80 = 97$
There are 97 passengers on the plane.
- $4 + 4 + 32 = 40$
There are 40 rows of seats on the plane.
- $25 + 25 + 8 = 58$
There are 58 pieces of luggage.
- $50 + 14 + 7 = 71$
71 trays of meals were prepared.
- $67 + 25 = 92$
There are 92 cans of drinks.
- $3 + 6 = 9$
