Money word problems
Grade 4 Word Problems Worksheet

1. 5 pounds of tomatoes cost $\$ 15.50$. How much does one pound of tomatoes cost?
2. A carton of eggs costs $\$ 2.90$ and a package of bacon costs $\$ 3.10$. How much does it cost to buy 2 cartons of eggs and 1 package of bacon?
3. A bottle of orange juice costs $\$ 3.50$ and a bottle of grape juice costs $\$ 5.30$. What is the difference in the price between the orange juice and the grape juice?

4. A jar of honey is $\$ 2.40$. How much do 4 jars of honey cost?
5. Two boxes of cereal costs $\$ 7.40$ and buying one box of cereal only costs $\$ 4$. How much do you save by buying two boxes at the same time rather than one at a time?

## Answers

1. $\$ 15.50 \div 5=\$ 3.10$

A pound of tomatoes is $\$ 3.10$.
2. $2 \times \$ 2.90=\$ 5.80$ for the eggs
$\$ 5.80+\$ 3.10=\$ 8.90$
It would cost a total of $\$ 8.90$ for the eggs and bacon.
3. $\$ 5.30-\$ 3.50=\$ 1.80$

The difference in price is $\$ 1.80$.
4. $\$ 2.40 \times 4=\$ 9.60$

4 jars of honey cost $\$ 9.60$.
5. Buying 2 boxes at once costs $\$ 7.40$.

Buying 1 box twice costs $2 \times \$ 4=\$ 8$.
$\$ 8.00-\$ 7.40=\$ 0.60$
Buying two boxes at once saves 60 cents.
