



Sequencing

Reading Comprehension Worksheet

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A parent or tutor should read to the student and help the student to record their answers.
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A <b>sequence</b> is what happens <i>first</i> , <i>next</i> , and <i>last</i> .
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Here are some examples. Write the number 1 in the box beside what happened first. Write the number 2 in the box beside what happens next. Write the number 3 in the box beside what happens last.

1. What happened first, next, and last?	1, 2, or 3?
Manny gave one of his toy cars to his friend.	
Now Manny has two toy cars.	
Manny had three toy cars.	



2. What happened first, next, and last?	1, 2, or 3?
In the afternoon, there was a rainbow.	
It rained all morning.	
In the morning, it started to rain.	

3. Draw 3 pictures to show the **sequence** of the rainy day. What happened *first*, *next*, and *last*?
