


Animals adapt to their habitats

Write a list of features of the polar bear and camel that allow them to survive in the place they live in.





Answers

Thick fur to keep them warm.	Hump for storing fat.
Large claws for walking on snow.	Nostrils can close to keep sand out.
A layer of fat under their skin to keep them warm.	Long eyelashes to help keep sand out.
White color to blend in with the snow and ice.	Padded feet to make it easier to walk on sand.
Strong legs to help them swim fast through icy water.	Thick fur to protect them from the sun's heat and provide warmth at night.
