

Mixed multiplication and division word problems

Grade 3 Math Word Problems Worksheet

1. Robin has 9 packages of gum. There are 15 pieces in each package. How many pieces of gum does Robin have?

2. 63 people are going to the zoo. There are 3 cars to take people to the zoo. How many will go in each car if the same number go in each car?

3. I have 80 cents to buy candy. If each gumdrop costs 4 cents, how many gumdrops can I buy?





4. Maggi had 3 packages of cupcakes. There are 4 cupcakes in each package. She ate 5 cupcakes. How many are left?

5. 58 children are taking a bus to the zoo. 2 children sit in every seat. How many seats will the children need in all?



Answers

- 1. 9 x 15 = 135 Robin has 135 pieces of gum.
- 2. $63 \div 3 = 21$ 21 people will go to the zoo in each car.
- 3. $80 \div 4 = 20$ You can buy 20 gumdrops.
- 4. $3 \times 4 = 12$ There are 12 cupcakes to start. 12 - 5 = 7There are 7 cupcakes leftover.
- 5. $58 \div 2 = 29$ The children will need 29 seats.
