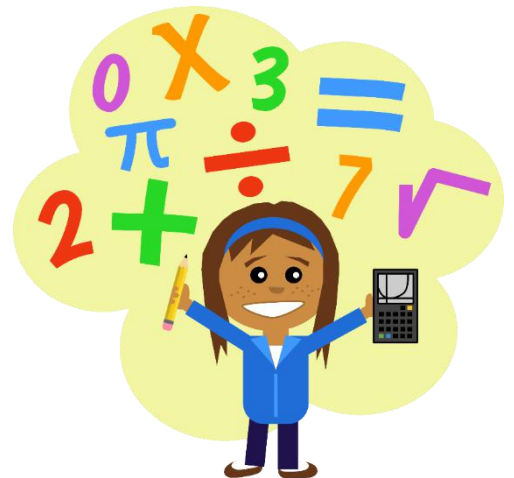


## Write equations with variables

6. Bryce had 25 toy cars. He gave 5 cars to his younger brother. Then, he lost  $c$  cars after he took them out one day. He only had 9 cars left.

## Answers

Note: there are several possible correct equations for each problem.

1.  $s + 5 = 20$   
 $s = 15$

2.  $6 - v = 2$   
 $v = 4$

3.  $4 + f = 14$   
 $f = 10$

4.  $15 - y = 8$   
 $y = 7$

5.  $r = 3 + 6 + 9$   
 $r = 18$

6.  $25 - 5 - c = 9$   
 $c = 11$
