#2: thermometer	an instrument used to measure temperature
#3: kilometer	a unit of length equal to 1000 meters
Prefix: tract-	Meaning: pull, drag
#1: distract	to draw away the attention of
#2: tractor	a powerful vehicle that pulls farm machines and heavy loads
#3: subtract	to take away from a whole or larger amount
